UpStage is a software development project that aims to create a web-based venue for online performance and cyberperformance.

Online audiences anywhere in the world are able to participate in live performance events by going to a web page, without having to download and install additional software and without needing to know anything other than a web address.

UpStage is [free to download](#) and we encourage you to use it for creative, educational and social purposes. It is open source and licenced under [GNU General Public Licence \(GPL\)](#).

The first version of the software was released in January 2004, and has been modified since. Download the latest version [from Sourceforge](#), (latest version 27 September 2004).
